At the center of the museum stands the original Spruce Goose. Built entirely of wood due to wartime restrictions on metals, this massive airplane stands as a symbol of American industry during World War II. Learn more about the history, first flight, and legacy of this mammoth plane. Step inside to understand just how huge this plane is.

While the Spruce Goose is the center piece of the museum, there is much more to see: General Aviation History, Space Flight, Military Aviation, Helicopters, The Oregon Aviation Hall of Honor and special movies – something for everyone.

Plan to purchase lunch at The Liberty Belle Café or the Cosmo Café; both serve the unique and special flavors of local farms. Or bring a sack lunch to eat outside, as food cannot be brought into the buildings.
