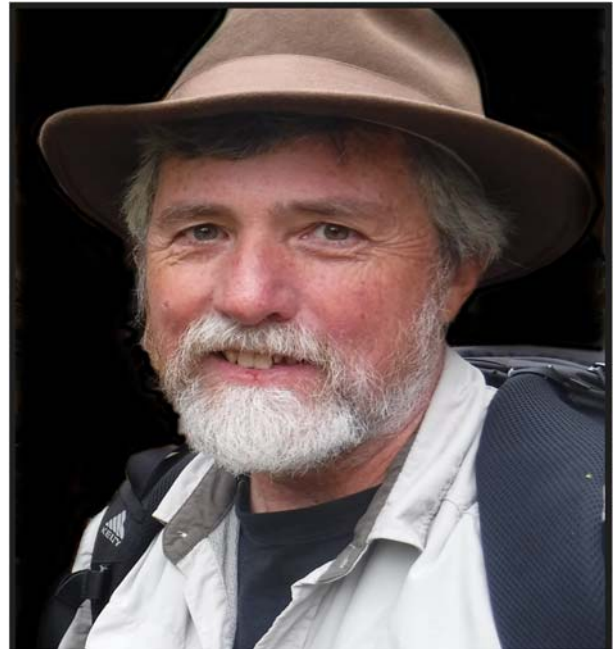


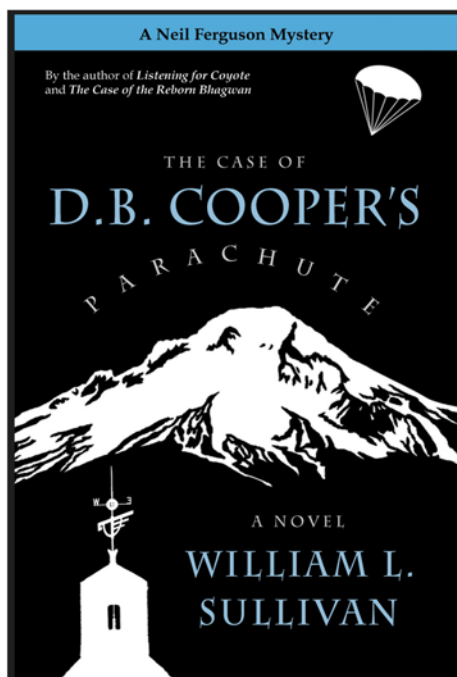


Campfire Tales with Bill Sullivan

Longtime Obsidian William L. Sullivan takes a short break from hiking to entertain us with campfire tales – legends and folk heroes of the Northwest from Bigfoot to Sacajawea, D.B. Cooper, and the Exploding Whale. Although Sullivan is best known for his popular hiking guidebooks, he has also written several books about Oregon history and half a dozen novels, including “The Case of D.B. Cooper’s Parachute”. His journal of a 1000-mile hike he took across Oregon, “Listening for Coyote,” was chosen by the Oregon Cultural Heritage Commission as one of Oregon’s “100 Books,” the 100 most significant books in the state’s history.
