

PLACE: North Cascades, Washington Camp Jacobsen III is located 12 miles north of Winthrop on the Chewuch River, at a site called "Sheep Camp". No...there are no sheep, just lots of lovely Ponderosa and Douglas fir. With a 5-acre site, there will be space for everyone and ample river front sites! This is a very beautiful camp location and the hiking is incredible! You will be surrounded by the North Cascades Wilderness to the west, the Pasayten Wilderness to the north, the Lake Chelan-Sawtooth Wilderness to the south and the Tiffany Mountains to the east.

DATE: Saturday, July 28 to Saturday, August 4, 2001

Campers are welcome to arrive on Saturday, July 28 after 1:00 p.m. The first official meal will be dinner that evening. The last meal will be breakfast on Saturday, August 4, and lunch fixings will be made available on the last day. Donald Burton and Jared Alexander have agreed to cook for us again this year!

COST:

Because of the low cost of the campsite, we are able to pass on a small savings in fees this year.

REGISTRATION:

- 1. Registrations will be accepted after January 1, 2001 in the sequence of their arrival. It is our intention to advertise Summer Camp to the general public after February 1, 2001. The membership will have the month of January to beat the crowd.
- 2. To register please fill out a Registration Form (found below make copies if necessary) and return one for each member of your party and send along with the deposit check. A non-refundable deposit of \$20 per person is required. Checks (one check for multiple registrations is OK) should be made payable to "Obsidian Summer Camp Fund" and sent along with a registration form for each person to:

FINAL PAYMENT:

Balance of Camp Fee will be due on or before June 1, 2001.

WAIT LIST:

- 1. Camp size will be limited to approximately 100 people. If more than this number register, a Wait List will be setup in the order of receipt of the registration form.
- 2. Persons on the Wait List will be contacted immediately, and told their position on the list. Should they wish to remain on the list, their checks will be deposited. Should the applicant's name move to the Final List, they would again be contacted. Final payment will then be due in full by June 1, 2001. Should the applicant decide not to remain on the Wait List, a full refund of the deposit will be sent immediately. Those remaining on the Wait List at time of Camp will receive a full refund of their deposit after Camp.

CANCELLATIONS:

It is recognized that sometimes cancellations are unavoidable. However, because there are some fixed costs, and to ensure fairness to those on the Wait List, the following rules will apply to those on the Final List:

- 1. The original deposit of \$20 is non-refundable.
- 2. Cancellations made more than two weeks before Camp begins: A full refund, less deposit, will be made if a replacement can be found.

- 3. Cancellations made less than two weeks before start of Camp:
 - a. If vacancy is filled, the full fee less deposit, will be refunded after camp.
 - b. If the vacancy is not filled, no refund will be made until after all Camp expenses have been paid in full. At that time, funds permitting, the fixed costs of camp will be determined and a percentage of the fee will be refunded.
